### Make your donations work harder ‘Gift Aid’ gives us more

The government gift aid scheme allows us to claim an extra 25 pence in the pound from donors who are UK taxpayers. This can add substantially to the donations given to a charitable event. £10.00 becomes £12.50, £20.00 becomes £25.00 so you can see the potential of using the gift aid scheme. All a donor has to do is tick the Gift Aid box and we do the rest. If ticked your donor is agreeing to the following:
